#### LOCATIONS

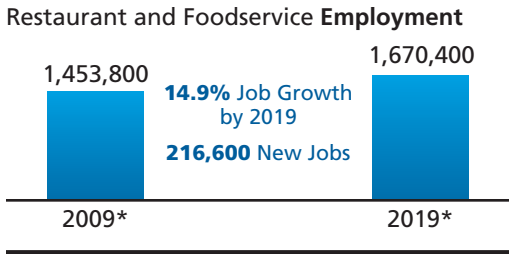
In 2007, there were **61,336** eating-and-drinking places in California.

#### STATE ECONOMY

Every \$1 spent in California's restaurants generates an additional **\$1.34 in sales** for California's economy.

Each additional \$1 million spent in California's eating-and-drinking places generates an additional **27.2 jobs** in California.

#### JOB



Restaurant jobs represent **10 percent** of total employment in California.

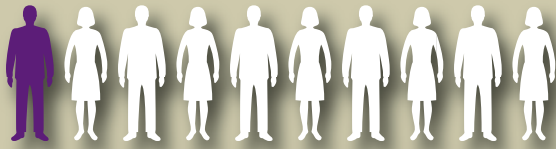
#### SALES

## America's Restaurants: By the Numbers

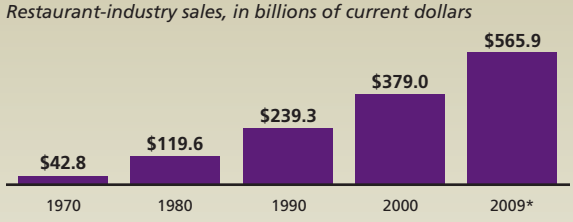
Almost **1 in 10** working Americans are restaurant employees
